You can enter the BWF Woodworking Project of the Year Award for:

A project undertaken by the company.

Craftsmanship – A joinery project that demonstrates excellence in woodworking/joinery.

Project Management – Underpins ability in delivering a project that really overcomes challenges to deliver for the client.

Excellence & Achievement – Evidence that the company has excelled in their technical application to reach a solution that exceeds the usual requirements and/or expectations of joinery product(s).

Entry Requirements

To enter, complete this Award entry form and submit it with the following information:

- No more than 500 words about the individual that shows how the entry meets the judging criteria;
- Photographs and any applicable technical drawings. A maximum of 10 photographs and/or drawings that best support the entry, to be sent in a separate digital file – either JPEG or EPS format.
- A reference from the client that the project was undertaken for.

Entry Rules

- Entries are invited for technical excellence and design for a woodworking/joinery project.
- For each award category you can submit up to two entries per company. Entries can be submitted for the same project in multiple Award categories.
- Nominations can be made directly by the company, or you can nominate another company.
- Previous winners or shortlisted entries cannot be submitted.
- Entry forms must be received by no later than 17:00 on Friday 1st September 2023

Awards Presentation

The BWF Woodworking Project of the Year will be presented at the BWF Awards Dinner on the evening of Friday 24th November 2023 at The Langham, London Hotel. Shortlisted entries will be notified of their success at least one month in advance to allow plenty of time to book tickets so they can celebrate their success and be there to accept the Award should they win the category.
